Access

Requests for access by individuals must be made via e-mail to themusicboxproject@icloud.com

In order to ensure that users have the skills to properly operate the equipment, they are required to fill in a booking form and complete an induction session before using the facility. Priority is given to users in the following order.

- 1. Users currently enrolled on the Music Box Project course (for whom the project was created).
- 2. Students currently studying Music Technology in secondary school / college.
- 3. Other young users who are interested in developing their Music technology skills

Booking a slot

• Studio hours are:

Week days 10am – 2pm Mondays and Tuesdays 5pm – 7pm

Music Box facilities are on a first-come first-served basis unless reservations are made. If the room is
reserved but not being used, others may use the space on a first-come first-served basis but must be
prepared to pack up and leave within five minutes if the person who reserved the room arrives.

- The default reservation duration is two hours. Your reservation is not official until you receive a confirmation e-mail. Requests are usually processed within one working day.
- You will be held responsible for all guests you bring to the studio and the state of the equipment once you sign in. Report any damaged or missing equipment immediately to the Bolney Meadow staff on duty in the centre.
- Excessive requests may be reduced or denied if needed to ensure the facility can be used by all students needing it, honouring the order of priority listed above, at the discretion of the centre manager

Studio Use

- Sign out when you leave the studio, even if you are stepping out momentarily.
- At the end of a recording session, return the studio to its original condition.
- Do not reconfigure any of the studio hardware or software without staff supervision.
- Treat the studio and equipment with care and consideration for others.
- No drinks may be used in the studio facilities with the exception of sealable or spill-proof containers.
- No food, alcohol, or tobacco may be used in the studio facilities.
- Occasionally the centre may take photographs of participants during session to demonstrate the popularity of the project to the funders.
